

Your ornament(s) will be available for pick up after January 9 in the Gift Shop at Sioux Center Health. Please include your email address and we will send you a reminder.


## Smit's Hospice Story

Ardel Smit (Mom) needed surgery in August of 2021 to remove life threatening cancer that had blocked a section of her small and large bowel. After the surgery, an infection hit and she started declining, and then we called the Sioux Center Hospice team in. Months later, Mom's cancer came back stronger, and she was struggling to eat without being nauseous. Hospice helped her with medication management so she could keep food down and have an appetite.

The cancer finally took her to join her family in heaven on August 17th, 2022. The day before her passing she was less responsive, and the hospice music therapist, Audra Olson came in to play hymns and sing, and Ardel was mouthing the words and tapping her feet as we all sang along. She was so at peace during that time. I had the opportunity to be praying over her when she took her last breath here on earth.

The Hospice Team was incredible with my Mom during her last year. With everything from nursing care, visiting, bathing, end of life discussions, music therapy, volunteer visits, and all the different types of visits, each and every person did their job well and always kept me informed on progress or when she was declining. This team was a Godsend to our family and we were blessed to have an extra year with her before God called her home. Their care reminded me of the hands and feet of Jesus.
