Ruth Hoekema Hospice Story

My wife, Ruthann Hager Hoekema, died at the age of 69 from a form of Congestive Heart Failure, Noncompaction Cardio Myopathy. Ruth was on hospice care from March 22 through March 30, 2023, at the Sioux Center Hospital. Because she had worked at this hospital for 39 years, nearly all the nursing staff knew and loved her. Her Hospice care was beyond excellent. The staff visited regularly, always asking after Ruth's comfort and mine. Kim, the Chaplain, came with fitting, personal words of comfort and care. Two visits from Audra, the music therapist, were very touching. I remember very vividly when Dr. Leightner prayed over us. How often do doctors pray as part of their care for a patient? Another vivid memory is when nurses, including one in training, asked to pray with me, holding my hands in the middle of the night. When Ruth breathed her last, two of her "best buds" were at her side. Ruth was pain-free and at peace with her LORD during her eight days on hospice, and hospice during those days also brought me peace. I cannot imagine any hospice care that could out-do the care we received from Sioux Center Health Hospice.
